## West O'ahu/Farrington Highway Guideway Contract

### Kiewit Field Work Roadwork and Traffic Update Week of September 4, 2011

#### **Traffic Impacts:**

- Crews will work along Farrington Highway between Ala Ike Street in Pearl City and Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) in Kapolei. Work will consist of:
  - Shaft work within the median of Farrington Highway between Leoku Street and Leokane Street.
  - Trimming and relocating trees within the median of Farrington Highway between Leokane Street and Pupukahi Street.

#### **Evening Traffic Impacts**

- Crews will work along the median of Farrington Highway between Aniani Place and Kahuali'i Street relocating utilities.
- Crews will work along the median of Farrington Highway between Kunia Road and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop.

#### **Weekend Traffic Impacts**

- Crews will be trimming and repurposing trees along the makai shoulder of Farrington Highway in front of Waipahu High School.

#### **Farrington Highway, H-1 and City Streets Traffic Plan:**

- Work will require lane closures with shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road to mark the work area during the following hours:
  - Daytime: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m.
  - Evenings: Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. – 5 a.m.
  - Weekends: Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- One lane of traffic in each direction of Farrington Highway will remain open in the designated work areas.

**\*There will be no lane closures on Sunday, September 4 and Monday, September 5 in observance of Labor Day.**
