



West O'ahu/Farrington Highway Guideway Contract

Kiewit Field Work Roadwork and Traffic Update Week of September 11, 2011

Traffic Impacts:

- Crews will work along Farrington Highway between Acacia Road in Pearl City and Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) in Kapolei. Work will consist of:
 - Trimming and relocating trees within the median of Farrington Highway between Pupukahi Street and Leoku Street, and Kahuali'i Street and Waipahu High School.

Evening Traffic Impacts

- Crews will work along the median of Farrington Highway between Paiwa Street and Aniani Place relocating utilities.
- Crews will work along the median of Farrington Highway between Kunia Road and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop between Waikele Road and Leokane Street performing soil sampling, requiring the following traffic changes:
 - Partial lane closure at the intersection of Pupukahi Street and Farrington Highway
 - Detour from Farrington Highway to Old Fort Weaver Road using Old Fort Weaver Loop

Weekend Traffic Impacts

- Crews will be clearing debris along the makai shoulder of Farrington Highway in front of Waipahu High School.

Farrington Highway, H-1 and City Streets Traffic Plan:

- Work will require lane closures with shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road to mark the work area during the following hours:
 - Daytime: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m.
 - Evenings: Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. – 5 a.m.
 - Weekends: Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- One lane of traffic in each direction of Farrington Highway will remain open in the designated work areas.
